

Major Local Endorsement by R&T Partners For Malulani Health and Medical Center.

KIHEI, MAUI—The Malulani Health & Medical Center is closer to bringing added and innovative care to Maui County and the Tri-Isle Communities, thanks to a \$50,000 contribution from Maui R&T Partners.

The gift was earmarked to help Malulani Health Systems, Inc. meet the financial requirements of applying for a Certificate Of Need (CON) from the State Health Planning and Development Agency (SHPDA).

For Dr. Ron Kwon, a Maui physician and President of Malulani Health Systems, Inc.'s Board of Directors, the gift's symbolic impact is equally important. This is one more confirmation of growing community support for a second medical center on Maui—this time by major players in the island's economy. Maui R&T Partners has two general partners. Haleakala Properties, Inc., a subsidiary of Haleakala Ranch, which owns much of the land at the Maui Research & Technology Park

in Kihei, where Malulani plans to build. Pacific Rim Land is headed by Steve Goodfellow, President of Goodfellow Bros., Inc., a civil contractor with operations throughout Hawaii and the Pacific Northwest. Maui Land & Pineapple Company is also a limited partner.

Maui R&T Partners have also granted Malulani Health Systems an option on 40 acres at the Research & Technology Park, which will place the new facility in the heart of Maui's fastest-growing community.

When the board of Haleakala Properties approved the donation, we were looking ahead," says Buzz Stuka, president of Haleakala Ranch and Properties. "Malulani will be a great addition to the park. It's needed, and it will encourage other development in the area. We see it as an economic plus.

The State Health Planning and Development Agency (SHPDA) has granted Malulani a public hearing in July. The final document is public record and is posted on the agency's website, www.SHPDA.org.
